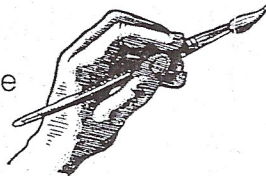

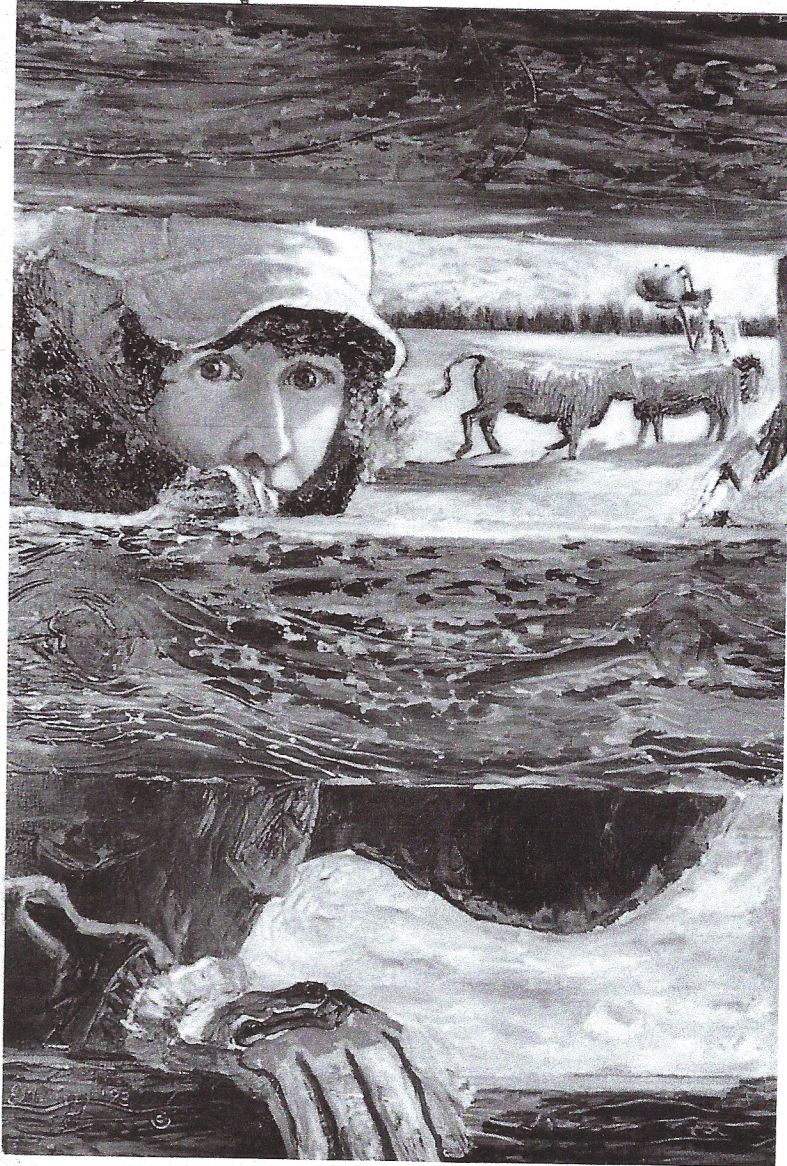

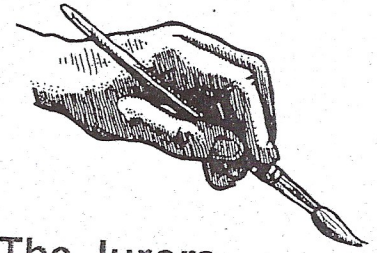

The Jurors

AMIR ALIBHAI is a Burnaby-based artist, teacher and curator. He received his BFA from UBC in 1989. As an artist, he has worked in site-specific installation, performance, and has exhibited in BC and Ontario. He has also worked with artists from across BC and through various venues and organizations as an independent curator and writer. Amir is co-founder of *Rungh* magazine, a South Asian cultural publication, for which he has guest edited. He is now working on his MA in Art Education at UBC.

CHICK RICE received her BFA from UBC, has a diploma from Emily Carr Institute of Art & Design, and attended the Master Class at the Banff School of Fine Arts. She is an artist/photographer who has exhibited and lectured in Canada, Europe and the US. Chick often explores issues of morality, philosophy, and spirituality in her photographic work. Her work has been collected by museums and galleries across Canada, published in periodicals and has won numerous awards, most recently the 1994 VIVA Award.

Jurors' Statement

The jurors recognize and respect all artists making art in BC. Our primary responsibility is to engage all participants in a dialogue about their work. Additionally, we will select works which will comprise *IMAGES & OBJECTS XIV* in Penticton. Although this will be a large exhibition, it can showcase only a small selection of the art being created in this province.

The basis for selection will be sensitive to the diversity of work submitted, in recognition that artists make art for different reasons and from different experiences. We will be looking for works that convey evidence of personal creative explorations, artistic commitment and vision. Jurors will also consider the execution of the work as related to the artist's intention.

1996 Peace-Liard Regional Juried Art Exhibition

1996 marks the 14th anniversary of a visual arts exhibition unlike any other in Canada. Images & Objects, the Assembly of BC Arts Councils' annual provincial juried show, is singular both in its intent and its realization.

It is the only provincial exhibition in the country to work from an entrenched grass roots base, as the 130 artworks which comprise Images & Objects are selected by jurors from 13 qualifying regional shows. It is the only example of a province-wide exhibition which brings together emerging and professional visual artists in a dynamic interchange achieved through a jurying and critiquing process at the regional level, and showcasing, educational and networking opportunities at the provincial level. It is the only such exhibition which, thanks to support from the BC Festival of the Arts Society, subsidizes participating artists to attend the exhibition and its accompanying conference. This exchange has strengthened the bridge between emerging and professional artists and has laid further groundwork for a mentor program.

What do we really mean by community? This is a question the Assembly of BC Arts Councils has been exploring over the past several years, and Images & Objects, through its support of community-based art and artists, is a vital part of this ongoing enquiry.

The 10 works selected from the Peace-Liard Region will be exhibited in Images & Objects XIV in Penticton, May 22 - 26, 1996.
